1. Bangladesh-China Power Company Limited has been allocated funds and intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Quotation Document is issued.
2. Detailed Terms of Reference (ToR) for the intended procurement are available in the office of the Procuring Entity for potential Quotationers during office hours on all working days.
3. Quotation shall be prepared and submitted using the 'RFQ Document'.
4. Quotation shall be completed properly, duly signed-dated each page by the authorized signatory and submitted by the date to the office as specified in Para 6 below.
5. No Securities such as Quotation Security (i.e. the traditionally termed Earnest Money, Tender Security) and Performance Security shall be required for submission of the Quotation and performance of the services (if awarded) respectively.
6. Quotation in a sealed envelope or by fax or through electronic mail on or before January 29, 2025, 12:00PM. The envelope containing the Quotation must be clearly marked "**Procurement of Load Test Related Service and subsequent Certification for different Lifting Equipment of Payra 1320 MW TPP**" and "DO NOT OPEN before January 29, 2025, 12:30 PM". Quotations received later than the time specified herein shall not be accepted.
7. Quotations received by fax or through electronic mail shall be sealed-enveloped by the Procuring Entity duly marked as stated in Para 6 above and, all Quotations thus received shall be sent to the Evaluation Committee for evaluation, without opening, by the same date of closing the Quotation.
8. The Procuring Entity may extend the deadline for submission of Quotations on justifiably acceptable grounds duly recorded subject to threshold of ten (10) days.
9. All Quotations must be valid for a period of at least 60 (Sixty) days from the closing date of the Quotation.
10. No public opening of Quotations received by the closing date shall be held.
11. Quotationer's rates or prices shall be inclusive of profit and overhead and, all kinds of taxes, duties, fees, levies, and other charges to be paid under the Applicable Law, if the Contract is awarded.



12. Rates shall be quoted and, subsequent payments under this Contract shall be made in BDT. The price offered by the Quotationer, if accepted shall remain fixed for the duration of the Contract.
13. Quotationer shall have legal capacity to enter into Contract. Quotationer, in support of its qualification shall be required to submit certified photocopies of latest documents related to valid Trade License, Tax Identification Number (TIN), VAT Registration Number, Bank Solvency Certificate, without which the Quotation may be considered non-responsive.
14. Quotations shall be evaluated based on information and documents submitted with the Quotations, by the Evaluation Committee and, at least three (3) responsive Quotations will be required to determine the lowest evaluated responsive Quotations for award of the Contract.
15. In case of anomalies between unit rates or prices and the total amount quoted, the unit rates or prices shall prevail. In case of discrepancy between words and figures the former will govern. In case of quotation submitted on Lump-sum basis, if anomalies found between figures and words, the words will prevail. Quotationer shall remain bound to accept the arithmetic corrections made by the Evaluation Committee.
16. The work should be initiated within 07 days from the notification issued from procuring entity.
17. The Agreement that constitutes the Contract binding upon the firm and the Procuring Entity shall be completed within **7 days** of receipt of approval from the Approving Authority.
18. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject all the Quotations or annul the procurement proceedings.

WHEREAS the Procuring Entity invited quotation for certain services named **Procurement of Load Test Related Service and subsequent Certification for different Lifting Equipment of Payra 1320 MW TPP** and has accepted the quotation submitted by the Firm for the execution of those works in the sum of Taka [insert Contract price in figures and in words] (hereinafter called “the Contract Price”).

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSED AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the General Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.
2. The documents forming the Contract shall be interpreted in the following order of priority:
 - (a) the signed Contract Agreement
 - (b) the Letter of Invitation
 - (c) the Conditions of Contract
 - (d) the Terms of Reference (ToR)
 - (e) the priced Bill of Quantities
 - (f) any other document listed anywhere in the Contract.
3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Procuring Entity to the Service Provider as hereinafter mentioned, the Service Provider hereby covenants with the Procuring Entity to execute and complete the service and to remedy any defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
4. The Procuring Entity hereby covenants to pay the service provider in consideration of the execution and completion of the service and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by the Contract.

**Conditions of Contract
for
Procurement of Load Test Related Service and subsequent Certification for
different Lifting Equipment of Payra 1320 MW TPP**

1. Conditions of Contract contained herein shall be binding upon both the contracting parties for the purpose of administration and management of this Contract.
2. Implementation and interpretation of these Conditions of Contract shall, in general, be under the Rules & Regulations of BCPCL.
3. The firm shall have to commence the Work within 7 (*seven*) days of issuance of notification from the procuring entity and complete in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract in accordance to the timeframe mentioned in the Terms of Reference (ToR).
4. The time and date for the performance of service will be determined by the procuring entity and the firm shall comply with the timings as it is crucial to manage site availability.
5. The firm shall comply with all the Terms of Reference for 'Procurement of Load Test Related Service and subsequent Certification for different Lifting Equipment of Payra 1320 MW TPP'. *Terms of Reference (ToR)* is attached herewith in *Annexure-01*.
6. The firm shall be entitled to an extension of the work schedule if the Procuring Entity delays in receiving the services or if Force Majeure situation occurs or for any other reasons acceptable to the Procuring Entity on justifiable grounds duly recorded.
7. The Procuring Entity shall check and verify the study executed by the Firm and notify the Firm of any Defects found.
8. Notwithstanding any testing and examination, the Procuring Entity by visual inspection or field tests may instruct the Firm to:
 - a. remove and replace any study or part thereof which is not in accordance with the Contract,
 - b. remove and re-execute any other study or part thereof which is not in accordance with the Contract, and
 - c. execute any study which is urgently required for the safety of the study.
9. The Firm shall submit to the Procuring Entity the progressive invoices for estimated value of services executed less the cumulative amount certified previously.
10. The Firm shall be entirely responsible for payment of all taxes, duties, fees, and such other levies under the Applicable Law.
11. Mode of payment shall be based on the type of the Contract corresponding to the Bill of Quantities:

Mode of Payment:
Payments shall be made only after successful completion and submission of report to BCPCL and duly accepted by BCPCL (Referred in ToR).
12. The total Contract Price is **BDT [] only including Tax & VAT.**
13. No works under Extra Work Orders shall be permissible and, works under Variation Orders (except in case of Lump-sum basis) shall under no circumstances exceed fifty (50) percent of the Contract Price subject to threshold specified in the Procurement Procedures and Delegation of Financial Power-2019 of Bangladesh China Power Company Limited.
14. The Procuring Entity contracting shall amend the Contract incorporating required approved changes subsequently introduced to the original Conditions of Contract in line with Rules, where necessary.
15. The Firm shall apply by notice to the Procuring Entity for issuing a Completion Certificate of the Service, and the Procuring Entity shall do so upon deciding that the service has been performed.
16. The Procuring Entity shall, within 07 (*Seven*) working days after receiving the Firm's application:
 - a) issue the Completion Certificate to the Firm stating that the works and service were completed in accordance with the Contract, or



- b) reject the application, giving reasons and specifying the works and service required to be done/redone by the Firm to enable issuance of the Completion Certificate.
17. The Firm shall keep the Procurement Entity harmless and indemnify from any claim, loss of property or life to himself/herself, his/her workmen or staff, any staff of the Procurement Entity or any third party while executing the work. Any claim arising out of execution of the works and service shall be settled by the Firm at his/her own cost and responsibility.
18. The Procuring Entity may, by written Notice sent to the Firm, terminate the Contract in whole or in part at any time, if the Firm:
- a) fails to sign the Contract or commence the service within the specified time.
 - b) fails to achieve satisfactory progress of works and service in accordance with the Programme of Works.
 - c) fails to complete the services as per Terms of References.
 - d) after receipt of a written notice from the Procuring Entity does not remedy its failure within the time period specified therein.
 - e) in the judgement of the Procuring Entity, has engaged in any corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for or in performance of service.
 - f) fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.
19. The Procuring Entity and the Firm shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all possible disputes arising out of or in connection with this Contract or its interpretation.

1.0 Background

Bangladesh-China Power Company Limited (BCPCL), a Joint Venture Company (JVC) of NWPGL of Bangladesh and CMC of China, is operating a coal-based 1320 MW Thermal Power Plant at Dhankhali, Patuakhali, Bangladesh. The plant consists of two (2) units of Ultra Super Critical Coal-Fired Power Plant each with a gross capacity of 660MW. The Company is currently doing its operation & maintenance of the plant. Different lifting equipment are used during the operation and maintenance of the plant, which requires to be inspected regularly.

BCPCL management intends to conduct load test and inspection of the lifting equipment.

2.0 Objectives of the Services required

To conduct load test and inspection of the lifting equipment at Payra 1320MW TPP Site.

3.0 Scope of Services:

The scope of service broadly includes the following-

- a. Review relevant manufacturer documents of lifting equipment.
- b. Review and feedback on previous maintenance & test records.
- c. Review and feedback on the maintenance management system of lifting equipment.
- d. Visual inspection before load test, after load test and in the running condition with load.
- e. Test of brakes, interlocks and other safety devices of lifting equipment.
- f. Static and dynamic load test and performance test of all lifting equipment.
- g. Issuance of inspection reports/certificates of load test.
- h. Sticker (with logo) tagging on successfully passed items.
- i. The load block rigging work must be carried out by the 'Service Provider' and thus manpower/worker should be deployed by the Service Provider.
- j. All lifting gears required to be inspected Service Provider.
- k. A comprehensive final report covering scope of services including findings and recommendations.

4.0 Location of the Services:

Payra 1320MW Thermal Power Plant, Dhankhali, Kalapara, Patuakhali, Bangladesh.

5.0 Reporting Requirements & Deliverables

The Service Provider shall prepare and submit a comprehensive report of load test and inspection of the lifting equipment to Plant Manager, Payra 1320MW TPP, BCPCL within 28 (twenty-eight) days of the contract signing.

6.0 Support to be provided by the Employer

Bangladesh-China Power Company Limited will provide access to all information and location to the service provider for all site activities. The service provider will work independently with his/her team in 1320 MW TPP site and surroundings for the assignment, to finalize methodologies and approaches. If required, BCPCL may provide office space to the service provider. All support services, logistics, and miscellaneous expenses related to the assignment must be borne by the service provider.

BCPCL will arrange the required load during load test to the Service Provider.



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7.0 Responsibilities of the Service Provider

The Service Provider shall perform the load test and inspection as outlined in the "Scope of Services" and "Responsibilities," ensuring the successful realization of the project in the best interest of the Client (Bangladesh-China Power Company Limited). This shall be executed with all reasonable care, skill, sound engineering, administrative, and financial practices. The Service Provider shall remain accountable to the Client for fulfilling these responsibilities.

The Service Provider shall deploy experienced personnel/workers as required, including riggers, crane operators, forklift operators, and operators for other engineering vehicles, ensuring that all operators possess valid experience certificates. Additionally, the Service Provider shall arrange insurance coverage for all working personnel/workers under their responsibility. Food and accommodation for all deployed manpower/workers shall also fall under the scope of the Service Provider.

The Service Provider shall assume full responsibility for implementing all necessary safety measures during the load test and shall supply all required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to ensure the safety of their personnel/workers throughout the assignment. Furthermore, the Service Provider will be held liable for any damage to plant equipment incurred during the load test.

8.0 Qualification and Experience of Firm:

Qualifications and experiences for the service provider should be as follows (Evidence of the qualification to be provided):

- Service Provider must be a nationally/internationally reputed one having registered office in Bangladesh.
- Must have experience with regard to perform similar assignment successfully.
- The Service Provider should have appropriate logistics and operational support team in Bangladesh.

9. Mode of Payment:

Payments shall be made only after successful completion and submission of report to BCPCL and duly accepted by BCPCL.

10. Duration of the Assignment

The total duration of the assignment will be 30 (thirty) days from the date of issuance of notification to conduct the testing of loading equipment.

11. Methodology Approach

The service provider is allowed to undertake any methodology approaches with regard to the assignment. Detail methodology approach should be submitted with the quotation.

12. Ownership of the Data, Documents, and Equipment

- BCPCL shall be the owner of all the data collected, data sets, reports, documents, etc. prepared by the service provider under the assignment.
- All documents, reports and information from this assignment will be regarded as BCPCL's property, so the mentioned outputs or part of it cannot be sold or used in any case without the prior permission of BCPCL.
